- 4. Upon verification/ confirmation by the college, the students will be eligible to submit their fees online in their account. In case of non availability of online payment process with the students, provision would be available to pay the fees of the students by the colleges.

Notice on Form fill-up for Regular&Backlog Students forEnd Semester (odd) Examinations 2020-21

The form fill up for the End Semester Examinations for Odd Semester 2020-21 would commence from 27th February 2021 as per following steps following approval of the competent authority in Covid-19 pandemic situation.

- 1. Application form would be available in the student's and college login for all enrolled students of UG and PG courses of odd semester 2020-21.
- 2. Students can submit the application online from their login. In case, there is problem of connectivity, college admin can submit the application on the basis of request from the student considering pandemic situation.
- 3. On submission of the form online by the student, the said form will be available in the college admin login for verification/ confirmation by the college.
- 4. Upon verification/ confirmation by the college, the students will be eligible to submit their fees online through different methods available. In case of non-availability of online payment facility with the students, provision would be available to pay the fees of the students by the colleges.
- 5. The regular and backlog form have to be filled up separately by the students.
- 6. After payment of the fee(s) student must download the form for future reference.
- 7. Process of collection of signed application forms would be taken care by the colleges, and such forms need to be submitted to the University in due course of time, as per notification/intimation for the same.
- 8. After submission of the fee, the admit cards will be generated online in the student login.
- 9. Provision of appearing in the online examinations would be available for the students for whom admit card is issued. The process of online examination would be notified separately.

Notice on Form fill-up for Back Paper Students in End Semester (Odd) Examinations 2019-20

Applications for appearing in end semester examinations, i.e. Form fill-up for all candidates having back paper in odd semester would be done as per following.

- Forms for all the Back paper candidates whose internal assessment (IA) marks are available, are now available in the college and students login for submission. On confirmation by the colleges, students would be able to confirm and take print of the application form. On submission of signed form to the office of the college, colleges concerned would process all such forms online and proceed for online payment of fees. On receiving online forms and requisite fees, admit card would be generated online.
- 2. There are some students whose IA marks are not available. Such IA marks for theory subjects at this phase would be captured through panel available in the college login. On uploading of such IA marks, concerned forms would be generated and on confirmation of the colleges, students would be able to confirm and take print of the application form. Students would then, submit signed form to the colleges and on further processing and submission of fees by the colleges, admit cards would be made available online.
- 3. There are some cases, where, IA marks are also not available for practical and sessional papers for back paper candidates. For such cases, IA marks of those back paper candidates would be captured during capturing IA marks for practical and sessional papers for regular students. And for all such cases, admit card would be generated only after receiving all IA marks i.e. for theory, practical and sessional papers.
- 4. However, missing marks for practical and end semester examinations (for the cases 3 above) would be captured along with regular students after appearing in the end semester practical and sessional examinations with the regular candidates.
