

Mechanism for Timely Redressal of Student Grievances including ragging cases

Our college provides a '**Ragging-Free**' campus for the freshers' students as well as for the existing students. The college is committed to maintain '**Zero Tolerance**' to any Ragging incidents. That is why we have still maintained the campus free from any such nuisance till date.

To maintain the campus ragging free, some strict measures is being taken every year and also it is ensured that quick and proper redressal of any student grievance regarding Ragging, few mechanism is being maintained:

1. As per UGC guidelines, we have both Anti-Ragging Committee and Squad, formed by the head of the institute. They are consisted of representatives of civil and police administration, local media, Non-Government Organizations involved in youth activities, representatives of faculty members, representatives of parents, representatives of students belonging to the freshers' category as well as senior students, non-teaching staff; and shall have a diverse mix of membership in terms of level as well as gender.
2. The college campus (1st year building / Main Gate Entrance/ Girls' Hostel/Boys' Hostel/Canteen Area/Library Building) have been installed with pictorial Flexes with Awareness regarding Consequences of Ragging and flexes with the contact details of Members of Anti-Ragging Committee and Squad. At anypoint of time the students can approach any of the members of these 2 squads for emergency requirement related with Ragging.
3. Separate bus facility to be extended to all 1st year students.
4. The members of Anti-Ragging Committee and Squad members remain present during the arrival and departure of bus to avoid any kind of nuisance.
5. During lunch break also, separate canteen facility is extended towards 1st year students to avoid any kind of interaction during 1st few days in the college.
6. CCTV cameras, throughout the college campus, have been installed in important location so that any untoward incident, if happens, can be tracked easily.
7. Surprise Hostel and Mess visits are also made by the Anti-Ragging Committee Membersfor monitoring the students well-beingness during their hostel time. Student's feedback is also taken during these type of surprise visits.
8. Special talk is being held with the students (Senior) regarding the consequences of ragging by HODs & senior faculty members of the department.
9. Frequent meetings (2-3 times /month) are called to get report from the members of the committee and any issue/problem if comes, is being addressed and the activities are evaluated.









6:00 : The members then asked the students to assemble in the Kitchen and addressed with the issues regarding any issue of physical and mental harassment of the seniors.

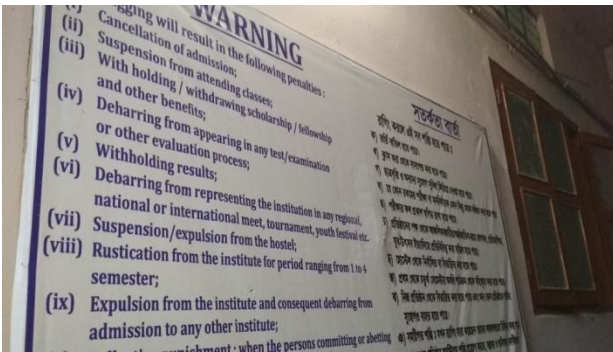
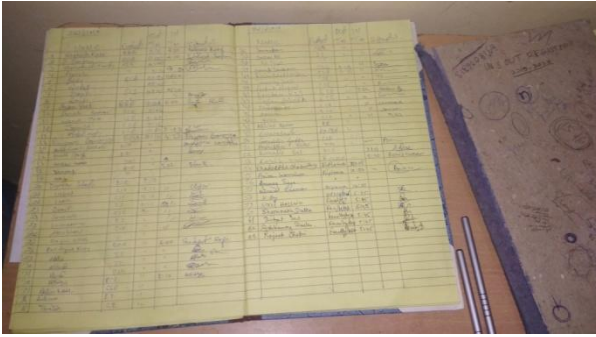

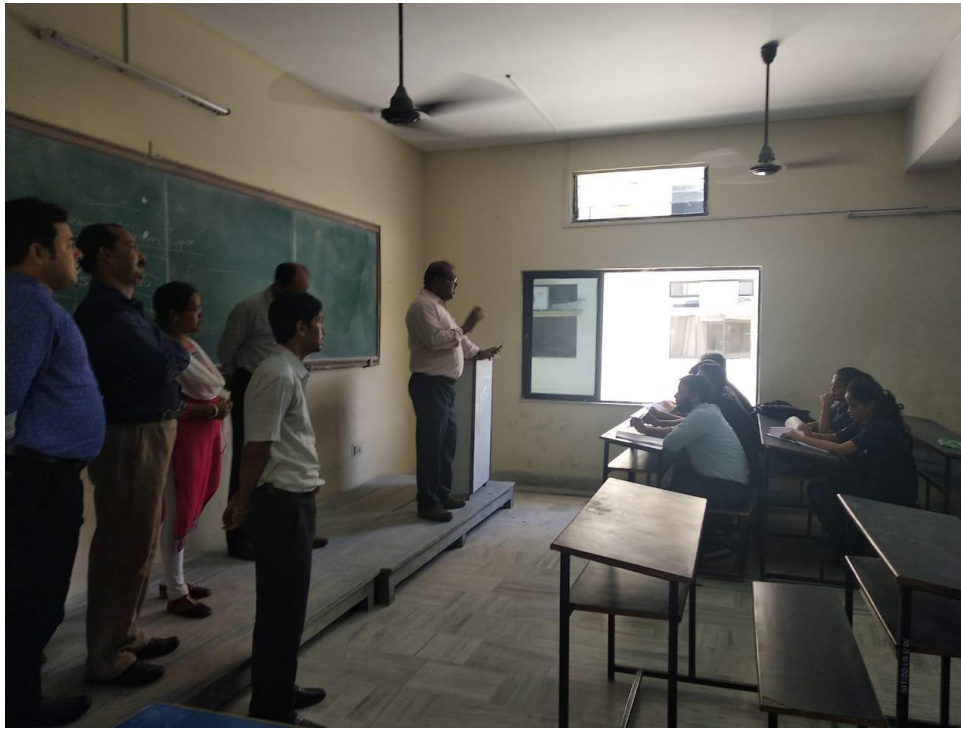

Brief Report of Holding Special Talk with Seniors Students of EE Department regarding the consequences of Ragging

Ragging is any disorderly conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness to any student, hardness or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student.

Thus, **Anti-Ragging Cell** makes sure that the menace of Ragging is completely prohibited in the institutional premises. Also the laws are very strict for any event of ragging, the consequences being equally strict. That's why special talks were arranged in EE department to meet the senior students and make them aware of the consequences of Ragging and make the institute **Ragging Free**.

Objective of the program: The objective of the program was to make the senior students

- Aware of the consequences of Ragging.
- Generate awareness of the laws and directives of Hon'ble Supreme Court on Ragging.
- Make them understand that not only they should restrain from Ragging, also they should advise others not to indulge in this menace.

Summary of the program:

The following points can be noted from the program

- All the speakers interacted with senior students of the department (2nd year and 3rd year).
 - Prof. S. Roy addressed the students and advised the students not to indulge in any sort of ragging related activities in the college. He also pointed out how a single incident of Ragging can put an enormous impact on the students. Also he requested the students not to lose temperament to any kind of provocation and report any such incident to the departmental Anti-Ragging Committee members rather than doing something by own.
 - Prof. J. B. Basu made the students aware of the strict laws and the consequences of indulging in any sort of Ragging and also reminded that the institute observes 'Zero-Tolerance to Ragging'. He inspired the students to continue the effort to make sure the campus stays 'Ragging-Free'. It was also mentioned how a single report in involvement in ragging activity can put an end to one's career.
